The Health and Safety Licensing Appeals (Hearings Procedure) Rules 1974

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Chancellor (on 3rd December 1974), made the Health and Safety Licensing Appeals (Hearings Procedure) Rules 1974, coming into operation 1st January 1975, under powers contained in the Health and Safety at Work etc., Act 1974.

Section 44 of the Health and Safety at Work etc., Act 1974, gives a right of appeal to the Secretary of State to

persons aggrieved by decisions of an authority having power to issue licences (other than agricultural licences and nuclear site licences) under Part I of that Act or under the
