STEVENAGE BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

The Stevenage Borough (Area No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1974

Notice is hereby given that the Stevenage Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 26th November 1974, made an Order entitled The Stevenage Borough (Area No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1974, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st October 1975, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Director of Administration and Legal Services' Department, 4th Floor, Southgate House, Southgate, Stevenage, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 19th December 1974.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The Order affects the area, being part of the Borough of Stevenage, whose boundary is formed by commencing at the junction of Broadwater Crescent and Oaks Cross and then proceeding north along the centre of Oaks Cross to its junction with Shephall Lane. The boundary line continues west along the centre of Shephall Lane to its junction with Shephall Green Lane, thence north along the centre of Shephall Green Lane to a point where it passes underneath Broadhall Way; the boundary line then proceeds in a south-easterly direction along the centre of Broadhall Way to a point where it passes over the Stevenage Brook. The boundary line continues south-west along the centre of public right of way No. 78 to its junction with the Hertford Road and thence along the centre of Watton Road to the Borough boundary. The boundary line continues in a north-westerly direction along the Borough boundary to a point (OS 2565-2140 Sheet No. TL 2521SE) which is approximately 156 yards south-west of the southern end of Ashdown Road. The boundary line continues in a north-easterly direction to a point (OS No. 2565-2140 Sheet No. TL
