Whereas the Secretary of State for the Environment, after giving to the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Parish of Great Gonerby, in the County of Lincolnshire, ten days' previous notice of his intention in that behalf, has, under the provisions of the Burial Act 1853 as amended by subsequent enactments, made a Representation to Her Majesty in Council that, for the protection of the Public Health, burials should be discontinued forthwith and entirely in St. Sebastian's Churchyard, in the said Parish, shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.

Provided that in any earthen grave now existing in the said Churchyard, the burial may be allowed of the body of any member of the family of the person or persons heretofore buried in such grave, subject to the condition that no part of the coffin containing the body shall be at a depth less than three feet below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.

Now, therefore, Her Majesty in Council is pleased hereby to give Notice of such Representation and to order that

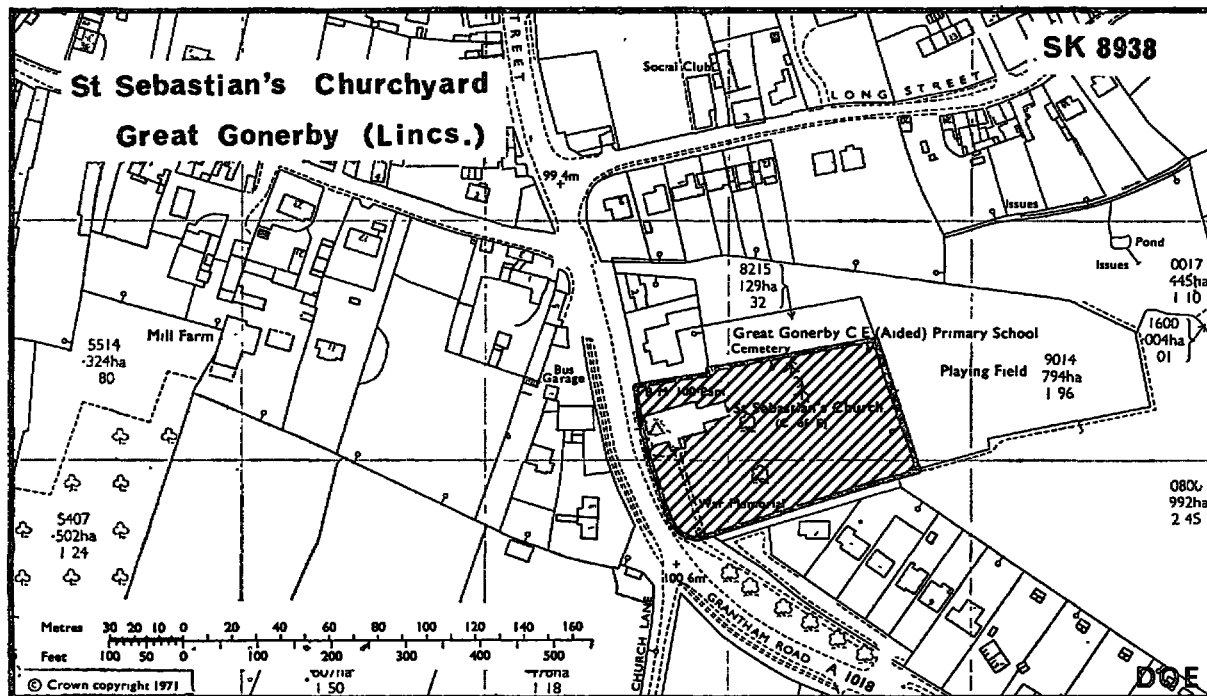
the same be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on the 14th day of February next.

The London-Holyhead Trunk Road (Gwalchmai By-Pass) Order 197

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment intends to make an Order under section 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, entitled "The Trunk Roads (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.) Order 1974" prohibiting the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
