Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Hartlepool in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above mentioned Act on the 24th January 1975 made an Order entitled the Borough of Hartlepool No. 28 Smoke Control Order 1974 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite coke and other carbonised fuels gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1975 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the office of the Borough Solicitor, Municipal Buildings, Hartlepool at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 14th February 1975.

The authorised fuels include anthracite coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st day of October 1975, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State.

A copy of the Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Department of Administration and Legal Services, Guildhall, Wrexham, and at the office of the Chief Public Health Inspector, Rhostyllen House, Rhostyllen at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 14th February 1975.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff, object to the confirmation of the Order.
