(Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order 1975

The Trunk Road (Raglan, Gwent)

(Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State intends to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the north-eastern carriageway of the Raglan-Llandoverly Trunk Road (A40) to make a U-Turn at the junction of the trunk road with Monmouth Road, in the County of Gwent, so as to proceed in the opposite direction in the south-western carriageway.
