Notice is hereby given that on 11th April 1975, the West Sussex County Council confirmed the above-named Orders.

The effect of the Orders as confirmed is to:

(1) Extinguish the public footpath (Path No. 560), in the Parish of Kirdford, commencing at its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 557), extending eastwards for a distance of approximately 770 feet to its junction with the public footpaths (Paths Nos. 594 and 561).

(2) Divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 557), in the parish of Kirdford, by stopping up the path commencing at a point approximately 160 feet north-west of its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 560), extending north-westwards for a distance of approximately 500 feet, and substitute for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the south-eastern end of the length of path to be stopped up, extending northwards, curving north-westwards along a headland for a distance of approximately 500 feet, to join the north-western end of the length of path to be stopped up.

(3) Divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 607) in the Parish of Kirdford, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the maintainable highway, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 430 feet, and substituting for that path, a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the south-eastern end of the length of path to be stopped up, extending westwards for a distance of approximately 130 feet, to join the maintainable highway approximately 300 feet north of Holy Trinity Church.

(4) Extinguish the public footpath (Path No. 558), in the Parish of Northchapel, commencing at its junction with the maintainable highway, extending southwards for a distance of approximately 200 feet, thence south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 800 feet to its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 557).

(5) Divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 551), in the Parish of Northchapel, by stopping up the path commencing at a point approximately 340 feet east of its junction with the maintainable highway, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 1,250 feet, thence north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 190 feet to its junction with the public bridleway (Path No. 559), and substitute for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at the north-western end of the length of the path to be stopped up, extending north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 340 feet, thence generally south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 1,000 feet to join the public bridleway (Path No. 559) at a point approximately 540 feet north of its original junction.

(6) Divert part of the public footpath (Path No. 3230), in the Parish of Northchapel, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the maintainable highway at Parkgate Farm, extending north-westwards for a distance of approximately 630 feet, and substitute for that path a new length of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing on the maintainable highway at Parkgate Farm at a point approximately 100 feet south-west of its original junction, extending generally north-westwards for a distance of approximately 620 feet, to join the original route at the north-western end of the length of path to be stopped up.

Copies of the Orders as confirmed and the maps contained in them have been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the office of the County Secretary, County Hall, Chichester, and at the Area Office of the Chichester District Council, Newlands, Pound Street, Petworth between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

The Order becomes operative as from 23rd May 1975, but if a person aggrieved by the Orders desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended or of any regulation

made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 2nd May 1975, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
