

## DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Crediton Road, Okehampton)  
(Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services and also for invalid carriages and vehicles issued to or used by disabled persons.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the West Devon District Council Offices, Oaklands Drive, Okehampton and at the address given below.

Objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 6th June 1975.

## THE SCHEDULE

*Crediton Road—*

North-west side, from its junction with Lopes Crescent north-eastwards for a distance of 31 metres (34 yards).

South-east side, from its junction with Leaholes Avenue north-eastwards for a distance of 60 metres (66 yards).

*Leaholes Avenue—*

North side, from its junction with Crediton Road eastwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards). (531)

*The County of Devon (Various Streets, Ashburton) (One Way and restrictions on Waiting) Order 1974*

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th May 1975, the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, amending and extending traffic restrictions in Ashburton.

When this Order comes into effect on the 12th May 1975 you will not be allowed:

(a) to drive your vehicle in the following length of road except in the direction stated:

That length of Kingsbridge Lane which extends from its junction with West Street north-westwards for a distance of 65 feet. From south-east to north-west.

(b) To leave your vehicle:

(i) at any time in specified lengths of East Street, North Street, Kingsbridge Lane, St. Lawrence Lane, West Street, Woodland Road and Vealena Terrace;

(ii) between 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, in specified lengths of East Street, North Street and West Street;

(iii) between 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, in specified lengths of North Street for a longer period than 30 minutes (no return within 30 minutes).

The restriction in (b) (iii) above will not apply to vehicles displaying an authorised disabled person's badge issued by a local authority.

Exceptions to the waiting restrictions will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- (c) collecting or delivering postal packets for the Post Office;

and, where necessary, in connection with—

- (d) the maintenance of the road, and
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the lengths of road in question, may be examined during usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at the address stated below or at the offices of Teignbridge District Council, Kingsteignton Road, Newton Abbot.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 5th May 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Bus Stops at Teignmouth)  
(Clearway) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th May 1975 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3), (3B) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When this Order comes into effect on the 12th May 1975, it will be unlawful, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or of a traffic warden, to cause or permit any vehicle, other than a stage carriage or a scheduled express carriage, to wait between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day in any prohibited area in Esplanade, Hermosa Road, Bitton Park Road (from its junction with First Avenue to its junction with Coombe Vale Road) and Dawlish Road, A.379 (from its junction with First Drive to its junction with Second Drive) at Teignmouth, which is bounded by white "bus stop" carriageway markings, and along which area is placed an 8 inch wide yellow line in the carriageway about 9 inches from the kerb line.

The only exceptions which will be permitted to the above-mentioned restrictions will be in cases where—

- (a) the vehicle is being used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or
- (b) the vehicle is being used in the service of the Devon County Council or the Teignbridge District Council or with the permission of either of the said Councils in exercise of statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used in such service it is necessary for the vehicle to wait within that prohibited area; or
- (c) the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop, or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident, or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control; or
- (d) the vehicle is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

Where any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any other Order relating to the waiting of vehicles, the provision of this Order shall prevail.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the prohibited areas in the specified roads, are available for inspection during normal office hours, Monday to Friday, at the offices of Teignbridge District Council, Kingsteignton Road, Newton Abbot, or at St. James' House, Teignmouth, or at the address given below.
