"Divert the public right of way which now runs from the disused railway at point "A" on the deposited plan, north-eastwards turning northwards and joins public footpath No. 12 at point "B" on the deposited plan to a line running from point "A" aforesaid north-eastwards in a straight line to join Public Path No. 12 about 15 metres north-east of point "B" (i.e., at point "C" on the deposited plan)."
