TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 209 and 212 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise:

- (i) the stopping up of the western side of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (ii) the extinguishment of any rights which persons may have to use vehicles on the eastern side of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The proposed Order will contain certain provisions for permitting the use of the length of highway specified in (ii) above by vehicles being used:

- (a) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if that vehicle cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road; or
