The Borough of Bournemouth (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 2) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th May 1975 the Bournemouth Borough Council acting as agent of the Dorset County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect on 2nd June 1975—

- (i) The County Borough of Bournemouth (Columbia Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1973 will be revoked and replaced;
- (ii) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Columbia Road from a point 53 metres (175 feet) west of Boundary Road to a point opposite the western boundary of 183 Columbia Road.

The usual exceptions will apply to loading and unloading goods, picking up and setting down passengers and certain works.

The Order will also incorporate without amendment the provisions contained in the undermentioned Orders made by the Bournemouth County Borough Council which will be revoked—

- (Acres Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970 ;
- (Beswick Avenue) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970 ;
- (Canford Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971 ;
- (Canford Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1971 (Variation) Order 1973 ;
- (Draycott Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970 ;
- (Ensbury Avenue) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970 ;
- (Ensbury Park Area) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1967 ;
- (Kinson Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972 ;
- (Service Road off Wallisdown Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967 ;
- (Turbary Park Avenue) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970 ;
- (Wallisdown Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967 ;
- (Wonderholme Parade—Kinson Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970 ;
- (Amendment of Orders permitting Limited Waiting) Order 1967 (in so far as it relates to Wallisdown Road).

A copy of the Order and the relevant map may be examined at my office between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the 20th May 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

- (B) (*Service Roads off Christchurch Road*) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1975
- (C) (*Poole Road*) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1975
- (D) (*Street Parking Places*) Order 1974 (Variation) (No. 3) Order, 1975
- (E) (*Street Parking Places*) Order 1974 (Variation) (No. 4) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th May 1975, the Bournemouth Borough Council acting as agent for the Dorset County Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 161 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council, made the above-named Orders under the appropriate provisions of sections 1 (1), (2) and (3), 28 (1), 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regu-

lation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The Orders will come into operation on 2nd June 1975. The Orders (A) to (C) make it unlawful to leave your vehicle on a part or parts of each of the following roads in Bournemouth during the hours stated:

- (a) *Suffolk Road* :
 - (i) at any time ;
 - (ii) for longer than 30 minutes in any hour between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- (b) *Service Roads off Christchurch Road* :
 - (i) at any time ;
 - (ii) between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. ;
 - (iii) between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. ;
 - (iv) for longer than 30 minutes in any hour between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. ;
 - (v) for longer than 30 minutes in any hour between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- (c) *Poole Road* :
 - (i) at any time ;
 - (ii) between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. ;
 - (iii) for longer than 30 minutes in any hour between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.

The usual exceptions will apply to loading and unloading goods, picking up and setting down passengers and certain works.

When Order (D) comes into operation a parking place 40 feet in length will be established on the north side of Poole Road for the exclusive use of disabled persons.

When Order (E) comes into operation a parking place 40 feet in length will be established on the northern side of Seamoor Road for the exclusive use of disabled persons.

Copies of the Orders and maps showing the restricted roads are available at my office where they may be examined between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 20th May 1975 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Borough of Bournemouth (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th May 1975, the Bournemouth Borough Council acting as agent of the Dorset County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The Order will come into operation on 2nd June 1975. When the Order comes into effect:

- (i) The County Borough of Bournemouth (Seabourne Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972 will be revoked and replaced subject to the variation in (ii) and (iii) below ;
- (ii) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of *Seabourne Road* from its junction with *Stourvale Road* to its junction with *Beresford Road*.
- (iii) Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the western side of *Seabourne Road* from its junction with *Stourfield Road* for 14 metres (45 feet) in a north-westerly direction.

The usual exceptions will apply to loading and unloading goods, picking up and setting down passengers and certain works.

The Order will also revoke and replace without amendment the undermentioned Orders made by the Bournemouth County Borough Council:

- (Beresford Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969.
- (Boscombe and Southbourne) (Prohibition of Waiting) No. 1 Order 1962.
