

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## HAVANT BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Havant (Service Road at Green Pond Corner, Warblington), Traffic Regulation Order, 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Havant acting on behalf of the Hampshire County Council pursuant to an arrangement entered into under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 propose to make an Order under sections 1, 28 and 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.

The effect of the Order will be:

- (a) To prohibit the use by vehicles of the service road situated to the east of Southleigh Road, Havant, at its junction with Emsworth Road (B2150) except by those travelling in a northerly direction.
- (b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 below.
- (c) To permit the waiting of vehicles as indicated in the length of road referred to in Schedule 2 below.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the restricted

roads referred to and a Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Town Hall, Havant, on any weekday (excluding Saturdays) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Objections to the proposed Order must be sent in writing specifying the grounds on which the objection is made to the undersigned by the 23rd June 1975.

## SCHEDULE 1

(a) Emsworth Road, Warblington (B2150) on both sides within 80 yards of its junction with Southleigh Road.

(b) On the eastern side of Southleigh Road between its junction with the said service road and Emsworth Road B2150 and on the western side between its southernmost junction with Berkeley Square and the said junction of Southleigh Road with Emsworth Road B2150.

(c) On the eastern side of the said service road from its junction with Emsworth Road (B2150) for a total distance northwards of 41 metres terminating at its northern junction with Southleigh Road.

(d) On the western side of the said service road from its junction with Southleigh Road for a total distance southwards of 25 metres.

## SCHEDULE 2

*Situation of Parking Place*      *Maximum period for which vehicles may wait in any hour*

On the western side of the said service road from a point 25 metres south of Southleigh Road for a total distance of approximately 10 metres.

NOTE. The Order if made will bring into permanent effect the experimental provisions for road traffic which have been in force in and around Green Pond Corner since February 1975, and present no change in those restrictions save for the waiting prohibitions in the service road (referred to in paragraphs (c) and (d) of the 1st Schedule) and the provision of a street car park as described in Schedule 2, all of which are new provisions. *Notice of Order relating to Off-Street Parking Places*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Havering hereby give notice that on the 21st May 1975 they made the London Borough of Havering (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1975 which revoked the London Borough of Havering (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1973 extended the order to certain additional parking places and increased certain charges for parking.

The Order will come into operation on 1st October 1975.

Particulars of the increased charges, the parking places to which the Order relates and the time limits and classes of vehicles for which the same are available are set out in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order and the Order to be revoked may be inspected free of charge on Mondays to Fridays inclusive between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Town Hall, Romford RM1 3BD and the Technical Offices, Harold Hill, Romford RM3 8UU until 4th July 1975.

## SCHEDULE

The charges proposed to be made for the use of parking places to which the proposed Order relates and the time limits and classes of vehicles for which they would be available, are as follows:

- (1) Free of charge for cars and motor-cycles, every day, 6 a.m. to midnight, for up to 4 hours (except as otherwise stated):

Billet Lane, Hornchurch (Old Ambulance Station—All Classes); Collier Row Road (adjacent to No. 117); Corbets-Tey Road, Upminster; (Hoppy Hall), Dorrington Gardens, Hornchurch; Fentiman Way, Hornchurch; George Street, Romford; High Street, Hornchurch (The Cricketers); Keswick Avenue, Hornchurch; Mavis Grove, Hornchurch; North Street, Hornchurch (Civil Defence); Red Close (Tesco Ltd.), Collier Row, Romford; Woodhall Crescent, Upminster; Billet Lane, Hornchurch Queens Theatre (Mondays to Fridays 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday 6 a.m. to 4 p.m., Sundays 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.); Bridge Road, Rainham (except Bank Holidays 9.30 a.m. to 10.30 p.m.).

Cherry Tree Lane, Rainham (6 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.); Elm Park Assembly Hall, St. Nicholas Avenue (9 a.m. to 6 p.m.); Front Lane, Cranham (6 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.); Gaynes Road, Upminster (except Sundays and Bank Holidays 9.30 a.m. to 11 p.m.); High Street, Hornchurch, Top Rank Bingo Hall (9 a.m. to 6 p.m.).

Oldchurch Rise, maximum 8 hours (all hours); Spilsby Road, Harold Hill, maximum 10 hours (6 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.); St. Lawrence Road, Upminster (2 hour limit); St. Nicholas Avenue adjoining Elm Park Hotel (8 a.m. to 11.15 p.m.); Park End Road, rear of Central Library, Romford (while driver visiting library Mondays to Fridays 5.45 p.m. to midnight, Saturday 9.30 a.m. to midnight (not Sundays) maximum period 12 hours.

- (2) Tariff A (see below) motor cars and motor cycles every day (except Sundays and Bank Holidays) 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. maximum period 12 hours except as otherwise stated:

Angel Way multi-storey, Romford;  
Como Street, Romford (6 a.m. to midnight);  
Junction Road, Romford (motor cars only all hours);  
Western Road multi-storey, Romford (motor cars only).

- (3) Tariff B (see below) motor cars and motor cycles (every day all hours, maximum period 24 hours):  
Havana Close multi-storey, Romford.
