The Brighton Corporation (Madeira Drive) (Parking Places and Restricted Waiting Order 1971) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that on the 27th May 1975, the Brighton Borough Council acting as agents for the East Sussex County Council, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 1, 35, 36, 37, and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

This Order which makes it unlawful to leave your vehicle at any time on the north side of Madeira Drive, from a point 1,285 feet east of the Palace Pier eastwards for 45 feet where it is intended to install a taxi stand, will come into operation on the 16th June 1975.

SCHEDULE

*Lengths of Road in the District of Huntingdon
Parish of Pidley-cum-Fenton*

1. That length of the B.1089 Oldhurst—Somersham Road at Pidley which extends from a point approximately 222 metres west of the B.1040 Warboys Road in an easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 577 metres.

2. That length of the B.1040, Pidley to Warboys Road which extends from its junction with the B.1089 Oldhurst to Somersham Road, Pidley, in a general north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 915 metres. (483)
