*The Greater Manchester County (Coniston Avenue, Worsley) (Prohibition of Waiting) (City) Order, 1975*

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to cause or permit any vehicle (unless that vehicle is displaying a disabled person's car badge issued by a local authority) to wait for a period exceeding one hour in any two hour period between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, on the lay-by fronting Nos. 2-12 Coniston Avenue, Worsley.

Exceptions will permit waiting for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods; and where necessary, in connection with;
- (c) the collection and delivery of postal packets by the Post Office;
- (d) building operations or demolition;
- (e) the maintenance of the said side of road;
- (f) the supply of gas, electricity, water and any telegraphic line.

## WIRRAL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Pye Road Car Park, Heswall (Weight Restriction and Restriction on Entry and Waiting) Order, 1975*
