TORFAEN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough Council of Torfaen (Gladstone Place, Sebastopol) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Torfaen acting under agency arrangements with the Gwent County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The proposed Order will make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

Exemptions to the Order will permit waiting for certain purposes including:

WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Wiltshire (B.3106 Holt to Staverton Road) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of

which will be that no person shall cause any "heavy commercial vehicle" (at present generally defined as a goods vehicle of over 3 tons) to proceed along that length of the B.3106 from its junction with B.3107 at Holt to its junction with the Staverton to Forewood Common road near Nestle's Factory, Staverton.

Exceptions will be included to permit such a vehicle to be used on the road for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the length of road and having access therefrom, or in the service of a local authority or statutory undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in an emergency by the Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance Service.

The alternative route for heavy commercial vehicles is via the Bradford Road (B.3107) from Holt to Forewood Crossroads thence on Road B.3105 to Staverton.

A copy of the draft Order and plan and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected at the County Solicitor and Clerk's Office, (Environment Division), County Hall, Trowbridge, and at the offices of the Director of Administrative Services, West Wiltshire District Council, Council Offices, Bradley Road, Trowbridge, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by not later than the 30th June 1975, quoting reference CNAW/LRC/ENV/PC.127(1).
