HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 to 1971

The M4 Motorway (Tredegar Park-St. Mellons Section) and Connecting Roads (Side Roads No. 3) Order 1975

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that in relation to the M4 Motorway which he proposes to construct at Castleton in the County of Gwent in pursuance of "The M4 Motorway (Tredegar Park-St. Mellons Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme 1973" he has made an Order under Section 13 of the Highways Act 1959 the effect of which is—

(a) to authorise him-

(i) to stop up parts of footpaths; and

(ii) to construct new highways which will be footpaths all on or in the vicinity of New Park Farm, Castleton; and

(b) to provide for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Gwent as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic. Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff and at the offices of Gwent County Council, County Hall, Newport, and Newport District Council, Civic Centre, Newport where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Copies of the Order the title of which is "The M4 Motorway (Tredegar Park-St. Mellons Section) and Connecting Roads (Side Roads No. 3) Order 1975" can be obtained from the Welsh Office, Roads Department, Graham Buildings, Newport Road, Cardiff CF2 1YU.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts or of regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to this Order may within six weeks from 9th June 1975 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.—Dated 16th May 1975.
