The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is expedient to provide for revised rates of retired pay, pensions, terminal grants and gratuities for Officers below Flag and General Rank, Petty Officers, Non-Commissioned Officers and Men of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines, for Officers and Ratings of the Women's Royal Naval Service and for Members of Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865, and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Citation

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pensions) Order 1975.

Interpretation

- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

General

- 3. The revised rates of retired pay, pensions, terminal grants and gratuities take into account the threshold agreement whereby naval personnel are in receipt of weekly and monthly additions to pay.

- 4. The provisions contained in this Order shall have effect from 1st April 1974.

- 5. The revised rates of retired pay, pensions, terminal grants and gratuities in respect of service in the Royal Navy, Royal Marines, Women's Royal Naval Service and Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service shall be as specified in the Schedule annexed hereto.
