SECTION III

Terminal Grants for Officers of Flag and General Rank and the Chaplain of the Fleet who retire on or after 1st January 1975

4. Officers of Flag and General Rank of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines and the Chaplain of the Fleet who retire from the Active List on or after 1st January 1975, and are awarded service retired pay under Section II of this Schedule, may be awarded a tax-free terminal grant of 3 times the annual rate of service retired pay awarded. The terminal grant will be awarded under the general conditions of award laid down in Orders in Council current at the time of the Officer's retirement.

SECTION IV

Service Invalidating Retired Pay and Terminal Grants for Admirals of the Fleet

5. (a) An Admiral of the Fleet who is invalidated on or after 1st January 1975, will be eligible for service invalidating retired pay at the rate of £11,500 per annum.

(b) An Admiral of the Fleet invalidated as in sub-Clause 5(a) above may be awarded a tax-free terminal grant of £34,500.

SECTION V

Service Invalidating Retired Pay for Permanent or Pensionable Officers of Flag and General Rank of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines and the Chaplain of the Fleet, who are invalidated on or after 1st January 1975

6. The provisions of this Section relate to Officers of Flag and General Rank of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines and the Chaplain of the Fleet, who are invalidated from the Active List on or after 1st January 1975, and who, subject to the general conditions of award laid down in Orders in Council current at the time of the officer's invaliding from the Service, may be awarded service invalidating retired pay at the following rates:

SECTION VI

Terminal Grants for Officers of Flag and General Rank and the Chaplain of the Fleet invalidated on or after 1st January 1975

7. Officers of Flag and General Rank of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines and the Chaplain of the Fleet who are invalidated on or after 1st January 1975, and are awarded service invalidating retired pay under Section V of this Schedule, may be awarded a tax-free terminal grant of 3 times the annual rate of service invalidating retired pay awarded. The terminal grant will be awarded under the general conditions of award laid down in Orders in Council current at the time of the officer's invaliding from the Service.
