HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

*The Raglan-Llandovery Trunk Road (Cefn Brynich Junction Slip Roads) Order 1975*  
and  
*The Raglan-Llandovery Trunk Road (Cefn Brynich Junction Side Roads) Order 1975*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Cefn Brynich near Brecon in the County of Powys, he has made under the Highways Act 1959:

1. An Order under section 7 which provides that two roads which he proposes to construct at Cefn Brynich near Brecon in the County of Powys shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation.
2. An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him:
  - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
  - (b) to stop up highways; and
  - (c) to construct a new highway,all at Cefn Brynich aforesaid and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Powys as from the date on which he notifies the Council that it has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Orders and of the relevant plans have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff, and at the offices of Powys County Council, Powys County Hall, Llandrindod Wells and Brecknock Borough Council, Oxford House, The Watton, Brecon, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Copies of the section 7 Order, the title of which is "The Raglan-Llandovery Trunk Road (Cefn Brynich Junction Slip Roads) Order 1975 (S.I. 1975 No. 759) can be purchased price 6p, through any bookseller or direct from Government bookshops (H.M.S.O.).

Any person aggrieved by the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may, within 6 weeks from 12th June 1975, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.

*The Trunk Road (Abergavenny, Gwent) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) (Wales) (No. 2) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, which will come into operation on the 16th June 1975. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of vehicles in any part of the carriageways forming those lengths of trunk
