

- (b) the deletion of a proposed road linking Oldham Street to Holland Street, and
- (c) the addition of a short length of new road linking Manchester Road to Holland Street.

The Department have been requested to agree that the Side Roads Order proposals should be further modified by the addition of a footbridge to cross the motorway in the Moorside Land/Angel Street area, but the Department do not propose a modification for incorporation in the Side Roads Order numbered 3 in the notice.

Plans illustrating the proposed modifications and a possible position for the Angel Street footbridge can be seen at the various places listed in the above notice.

Wessex Water Authority

An application having been received from the Wessex Water Authority for the variation of the main river map of their area, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in pursuance of section 2 (7) of, and paragraph 11 (2) of Schedule 2 to, the Water Act 1973, hereby gives notice of his intention to vary the said main river map in accordance with the proposals described below.

The effect of the proposals will be to confer on the Wessex Water Authority alone the power to exercise certain land drainage and flood prevention functions (including maintenance) in relation to the added watercourses and to release the Authority from such functions in relation to the deleted watercourses.

ADDITIONS

1. The proposed pipeline outfall from Blind Yeo to New Blind Yeo near Strode Road, Clevedon Parish, Woodspring District, Avon.
2. The New Blind Yeo River Channel from Clevedon Boundary Rhyne near Moat Cottage to the Blind Yeo, Clevedon Parish, Woodspring District, Avon.
3. The Kenn pipeline from the River Kenn near Treblehouse Farm to Kingston Pill, Clevedon and Kingston Seymour Parishes, Woodspring District, Avon.
4. The new course of the River Yeo near Yeo Bank Farm, Kingston Seymour and Wick St. Lawrence Parishes, Woodspring District, Avon.
5. A new channel of the River Lox Yeo, part of the M5 Motorway works, from Loxton to the River Axe near Hams Lane, Loxton Parish, Woodspring District, Avon; and East Brent and Compton Bishop Parishes, Sedgemoor District, Somerset.
6. Blind Pill Rhyne from the River Mark Yeo near Rooks Bridge, together with the Brent River (Motorway channel) to the River Brue near Highbridge, within the parishes of East Brent, Brent Knoll, Burnham Without, Burnham-on-Sea and Highbridge and East Huntspill Sedgemoor District, Somerset.
7. A new channel of the South Drain at Edington Burtle Station, Edington Parish, Sedgemoor District, Somerset.
8. A proposed new channel of the River Sheppey at Coxley Mill, St. Cuthbert Out Parish Mendip District, Somerset.
