ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

CARRICK DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Carrick District Council (Falmouth) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that, on 30th May 1975, the Carrick District Council made the above named Order under section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and in accordance with Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972. The Order will come into effect on 1st July 1975 and its effect will be to control the use of the parking places named in the First Schedule to this Notice which shows the classes of vehicles, the days and times of operation, and the maximum period for waiting in the parking places referred to therein. The Second Schedule hereto indicates the scale of charges for each parking place. The Order specifies the conditions under which the parking places may be used.

A copy of the Order containing full details, together with a map showing the location of the parking places, may be inspected at the Department of the Solicitor, The Council Offices, River Street, Truro, between the weekday hours of 8.45 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. (excluding 1 p.m. to 2 p.m. daily) and 8.45 a.m. to 4.45 p.m. on Fridays.
