TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 to 1971

North Devon Link Road (M.5 Sampford Peverell-Rifton Gate) Order 197
