ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

SOUTH BEDFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

The South Bedfordshire District (Various Roads) (Leighton Buzzard and Linslade) (Traffic Restrictions) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that: on the 6th June 1975, the South Bedfordshire District Council made an Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the Bedfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act, 1972.

The effect of the Order is to:

(a) Modify the existing traffic restrictions in Leighton Road, North Street, High Street, Hockliffe Street and Lake Street.
