The Wirral Metropolitan Borough Council, Stanley Lane, Eastham (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Wirral Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles proceeding in that length of Stanley Lane bounded by St. Mary's Church and the traffic island, except to obtain access to the Church.

The prohibition imposed by the Order will not apply:

- (a) so as to prevent a vehicle from being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or any of the services therein;
- (b) to a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) to a vehicle being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to any premises situated in that road.
