##### *De Grouchy Street, West Kirby (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Wirral Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside, propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles to enter De Grouchy Street from its junction with Darmonds Green except to obtain access to premises in De Grouchy Street.

The Prohibition by the Order will not apply:

- (a) so as to prevent a vehicle from being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or any of the services therein;
- (b) to a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) to a vehicle being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to any premises situated in that road.

##### *Pasture Road, Moreton (Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Wirral Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside, propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any person to cause any vehicle proceeding in either of the northern carriageway or the southern carriageway, as the case may be, of Pasture Road, Moreton, to make a U-turn in the said lengths of the road as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

##### *Reeds Lane, Leasowe (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Wirral Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside, propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time during the whole 24 hours on all days in the lengths and on the sides of the roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order for vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight, to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded, to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, and to enable a vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for a period of up to two hours for users of cars displaying the orange badge issued to disabled persons.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act of 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act of 1967, as so amended, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 3rd June 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
