Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to regulate traffic at Redruth by:

- (i) prohibiting any vehicle from entering Hendy's Lane (Unclassified) from Fore Street.

The County of Cornwall (East Portholland-St. Michael Caerhays Road) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to apply to the Secretary of State for the Environment for consent to the making of an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be:

- (1) to prohibit the driving of vehicles in that length of the East Portholland-St. Michael Caerhays Road (Unclassified) in the Parish of St. Michael Caerhays which extends between points 191 yards and 297 yards east of its junction with the Portholland-Polgrain Road.
