Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this Notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Arundel: Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order, 1975.

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th June 1975, the West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effects of which are:

1. to alter the waiting restrictions in certain lengths of the High Street to limited waiting (1 hour in any 2 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive);
2. to alter the waiting restrictions in part of the High Street from a prohibition of waiting at all times to a prohibition between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.;
3. to introduce limited waiting (1 hour in any 2 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, inclusive) in various lengths of the High Street and Tarrant Street;
4. to prohibit waiting at all times on all sides of the War Memorial, High Street, and in certain lengths of the High Street, Tarrant Street, Arun Street and The Square;
5. to prohibit vehicles proceeding south-eastwards along the High Street, Arundel, from making a right-hand turn into The Square.

The usual exceptions are provided in the Order, which will come into operation on the 25th June 1975.

A copy of the Order, and a map showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates, may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the 18th June 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The County Council of West Sussex (Southbourne: Link Road between Queen Street and Emsworth Inner Relief Road (A.27)) (One-way Traffic and Prohibition of Right-hand Turn) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th June 1975 the West Sussex County Council made an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, by Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and by

Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effects of which are:

- (1) to prohibit the driving of any vehicle in the link road between Queen Street and the Emsworth Inner Relief Road (A.27) near Hermitage Bridge, in the Parish of Southbourne, otherwise than from south to north; and
- (2) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a northerly direction in the link road between Queen Street and Emsworth Inner Relief Road (A.27) near Hermitage Bridge in the Parish of Southbourne, from making a right-hand turn into the Emsworth Inner Relief Road (A.27).

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Midhurst: Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, by Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

(1) To prohibit waiting at all times in certain lengths of the following roads in the Parish of Midhurst:

Red Lion Street.
Pople Hill.
St. Ann's Hill.
South Street.
Edinburgh Square.
White City Road.
Church Hill.
Market Square Road.
Bepton Road.

(2) To restrict waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in certain lengths of the following roads, in the Parish of Midhurst:

South Street,
Market Square.
The Wharf.
Market Square Road.
Sheep Lane.

(3) To introduce limited waiting (1 hour in any 3 hours, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive) in certain lengths of the following roads, in the Parish of Midhurst:

Red Lion Street.
Sheep Lane.
South Street.
St. Ann's Hill.
Church Hill.
Bepton Road.
Edinburgh Square.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable vehicles to stop and pick up and set down passengers, goods or merchandise, to wait when engaged in building operations or the repair of the roads or the services therein, or to take in petrol, oil, air or water from a garage, and in connection with funerals. The restrictions will not apply to invalid carriages and disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position disabled persons badges issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975.
