WATER RESOURCES ACT 1963-71

Licence to Abstract Water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Welsh National Water Development Authority (WNWDA) by the North-West Water Authority (NWWA) for a licence to abstract 104.4 mgd, 38,210.4 mgy of water from the River Dee at all or any of the following points of abstraction and subject to the following maxima daily abstractions from these abstraction points:—

Huntingdon	NGR 414634	96 mgd
Dee Bridge	NGR 407658	30 mgd
Heron Bridge	NGR 412643	52 mgd

In addition, application is being made to abstract the following quantities from all or any of the above abstraction points subject to the conditions specified:—

- (1) 6 mgd, 906 mgy during the 5 months November to March (inclusive) in any winter period.
- (2) 10 mgd, 1830 mgy when the flow of water in the River Dee measured at Farndon is significantly in excess of the prescribed flow in the River Dee.

All the above abstractions, if authorised, would be subject to the general directions and drought general directions issued by the WNWDA under Section 9 of the Dee and Clwyd River Authority Act 1973. The overall continuous abstraction from the Dee presently authorised by the following licences, which would be revoked on the granting of this present application, would be increased by 7.6 mgd, 2781.6 mgy.
