Somerset (Route B.3081 at Prestleigh) (Prohibition of Entry) (No. 1) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th June 1975, the Somerset County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which prohibits any vehicle proceeding along the Ringwood to south-east Shepton Mallet road (B.3081) from Bruton to its southern junction with the Wincanton to Weston-super-Mare road (A.371) at Prestleigh Point from entering the northern slip road, linking the B.3081 to the A.371.

The Order will come into operation on the 23rd June 1975.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

Somerset (Various Roads at Ilminster) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-way Traffic) (No. 1) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th June 1975, the Somerset County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to:

- prohibit waiting by vehicles on the sides and lengths of road specified in Schedule 1;
- prohibit waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the length of road specified in Schedule 2;
- prohibit the driving of vehicles in the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of the Schedule.

Exceptions have been made in the Order in respect of (a) and (b) above to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle, to load or unload goods, to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the maintenance of roads or services therein, and in respect of disabled persons' vehicles, subject to conditions.

The Order will come into operation on the 21st October 1975, upon the expiry of the Somerset (Various Streets at Ilminster) (Experimental Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) (Extension No. 1) Order 1975.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the lengths of road to which it relates, may be inspected at the District Office, Yeovil District Council, Council Offices, Ilminster, or at County Hall, Taunton, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds it is not

within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
