STAFFORD COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT. 1967

The County of Stafford (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 18th June 1975 made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

1. The effect of this Order is to amend any Order made prior to 18th June 1975 by or on behalf of Staffordshire County Council or by any Authority previously exercising such powers prior to 1st April 1974, in the present administrative County of Stafford in exercise of the powers contained in sections 1, 6 or 9 of the Act of 1967 the effect of which is to:

(i) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles, or any class of vehicles in a road or part of a road, except for the purpose of loading or unloading, and

(ii) In relation to a particular vehicle to prohibit that vehicle from waiting in that road or that part of a road at all times in any day or during one or more specified periods in any day, the following provisions shall also have effect:

Nothing in this Order:

(a) in a case where the period of the prohibition is of 2 hours' duration or less, for the whole of that period, and

(b) in a case where the period of the prohibition is of more than 2 hours' duration, for a period of 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than I hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road or part of a road on the same day)

shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle in relation to which the following requirements are satisfied:

(i) in all cases a disabled person's badge is displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle; and
(ii) in the case mentioned in (b) above, a parking disc, issued by a local authority complying with the require-ments of the British Standard Specification for Parking ments of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631: 1970), coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, is displayed in a relevant position on the vehicle, and the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, marks on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting has begun.

Provided that the exemption provision referred to above shall not apply to any bus lane or to any length of road specified in this Order during any periods in respect of

which the loading of goods on to or the unloading of goods from any vehicle is prohibited or to any length of road which is a bus lane within the meaning of Regulation 3 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975.

2. In this Order the expressions "disabled person", "disabled person's badge", "disabled person's vehicle" and "road" shall have the meanings ascribed to them by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations, 1075 1975.
