*Sevenoaks District Council (F.P. 655 Cowden)
Public Path Extinguishment Order No. 1 1974*

Notice is hereby given that the above Order, made on the 1st August 1974, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order, by the Sevenoaks District Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to extinguish the public right of way over the footpath numbered 655 in the Parish of Cowden leading north-eastwards from its commencement at Furnace Lane, Cowden, near Basings Cottage, for a distance of 700 feet or thereabouts to its junction with B.R. 654 Cowden.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Argyle Road, Sevenoaks, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on weekdays, Monday to Friday.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Sevenoaks District Council, Council Offices, Argyle Road, Sevenoaks, Kent, before the 25th July 1975, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Sevenoaks District Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

Somerset (Footpaths No. 30/14 and 30/25 and Bridleway No. 30/14 at Yeovilton) Public Path Stopping Up and Diversion Order, 1975.

Notice is hereby given, that on 2nd June 1975, the Somerset County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is

(1) to divert that part of public footpath No. 30/14 which runs from its junction with bridleway No. 30/14 for a distance of approximately 13 yards in a south-easterly

direction, (2) to stop-up public footpath No. 30/25 from its junction with the unclassified County Road linking Route A303 with Route A372 at Podimore at a point near the former Smithy to its junction with the unclassified road leading from Route A372 to Bridgelyampton at a point approximately 400 yards north-west of Stockwith Cross, and (3) to divert that part of bridleway No. 30/14 from a point approximately 15 yards west of its junction with footpath No. 30/14 for a distance of approximately 550 yards in a generally north-north-easterly direction.

The diversion route for bridleway and footpath No. 30/14 to run from a point approximately 15 yards west of the former junction of bridleway No. 30/14 and footpath No. 30/14 south-easterly for a distance of approximately 10 yards over a bridge across the River Cam then in a generally north-north-easterly direction alongside the eastern bank of the River Cam for a distance of approximately 623 yards to rejoin bridleway No. 30/14.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Yeovil District Council, Secretary's Department, 91 Preston Road, Yeovil, during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 5th July 1975, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provisions contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 20th June 1975, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

West Sussex County Council (Burpham) Public Path (No. 2214) Diversion Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that on 30th May 1975, the West Sussex County Council confirmed the above-named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert part of the public bridleway (Path No. 2214) in the Parish of Burpham, by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the public footpath (Path No. 2251), extending generally southwards for a distance of approximately 5,400 feet and substituting for that path a new length of public bridleway, a minimum width of 9 feet, commencing at the northern end of the length of path proposed to be stopped up, extending generally southwards for a distance
