West Glamorgan County Council (Eagle Street and Access Lane, Tanygroes Street, Port Talbot) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1975.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of West Glamorgan propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on any of the sides of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The proposed Order will provide for the usual exemptions for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading building and road works, the maintenance of essential services funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the sides of roads to which they relate may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 215, County Clerk's Department, The Guildhall, Swansea.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 19th day of July 1975.

SCHEDULE

Eagle Street (West Side)

From a point opposite the northern boundary of No. 12 Eagle Street to a point in line with the northern kerbline of Tanygroes Street, a distance of approximately 70 metres.

Access Lane—Manor Street/Tanygroes Street

Both sides from a point in line with the northern kerbline of Tanygroes Street to a point in line with the southern kerbline of Manor Street, a distance of approximately 70 metres.

(Various Streets, Brynhyfryd)

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of West Glamorgan propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive, on any of the lengths or sides of roads specified in the Schedule below.

The proposed Order will provide for the usual exemptions for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance of essential services, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the sides of roads to which they relate, may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 215, County Clerk's Department, The Guildhall, Swansea.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 19th July 1975.

SCHEDULE

Cwm Level Road (West Side). From the junction with Llangyfelach Road and the termination of the existing Order to a point opposite the junction with Siloh Road, a distance of approximately 73 metres.

Cwm Level Road (East Side). From the junction with Llangyfelach Road and the termination of the existing Order to the junction with Siloh Road, a distance of approximately 82 metres.

Brynhyfryd Square (South Side). From the junction with Llangyfelach Road and the termination of the existing Order to the junction of Eaton Road, a distance of approximately 44 metres.

Brynhyfryd Square (North Side). From the junction with Llangyfelach Road and the termination of the existing Order to a point opposite the western kerbline of Eaton Road, a distance of approximately 54 metres.

Eaton Road (West Side). From the junction with Penfilia Road to the southern boundary of No. 97 Eaton Road, a distance of approximately 44 metres.

Eaton Road (East Side). From the junction with Brynhyfryd Square to a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 97 Eaton Road, approximately 41 metres.

Penfilia Road (North Side). From the eastern boundary of No. 76 Penfilia Road to a point opposite the western kerbline of Eaton Road, a distance of approximately 62 metres.

Penfilia Road (South Side). From a point opposite the eastern boundary of No. 76 Penfilia Road to the junction of Eaton Road, a distance of approximately 54 metres.

(Main Road and School Road, Llanrhidian)

(Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be as follows:

(1) *To Prohibit Waiting at any time on :*
the east side of the main road between Marsh Road and Route B.4295 and
the west side of the main road from the northern side of the junction with Malt Hall to the northern boundary of the property known as Mount Pleasant.

(2) *To make School Road One Way :*
in a north-westerly direction, i.e. from Route B.4295 to the junction with Malt Hall.

The proposed Order will provide for the usual exemptions for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, delivery of postal packets by the Post Office and the maintenance of essential services and will also allow road sweeping vehicles to proceed against the one-way direction between certain hours.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads affected and a statement of reasons for the making of the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at Room 215, County Clerk's Department, The Guildhall, Swansea.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing stating the grounds for such objections to the undersigned by the 19th July 1975.

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

West Glamorgan County Council (Rheanfa Land, Swansea) (One Way Traffic) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be that traffic will proceed in a north-easterly direction only on Rheanfa Lane, Swansea, i.e. from its junction with Fynnone Drive to the junction with Terrace Road.

An exemption will be provided in the Order to enable a mechanical road sweeper to operate during certain hours.
