PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS
AND CLEAN AIR ACT

METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF CALDERDALE

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

*The Calderdale (Todmorden-Portsmouth/Cornholme/
Pudsey/Vale) No. 11 Smoke Control Order, 1975*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Calderdale in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 4th June 1975, made an Order entitled *The Calderdale (Todmorden-Portsmouth/Cornholme/Pudsey/Vale) No. 11 Smoke Control Order 1975*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emissions of smoke were not caused by the use of fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Also, in accordance with the Clean Air Act 1968, section 9 (1), any person who:

(a) acquires any solid fuel, other than an authorised fuel, for use in a building in a smoke control area otherwise than in a building or fireplace exempted;

or

(b) acquires any solid fuel other than an authorised fuel, for use in a boiler or plant to which this paragraph applies in a smoke control area, not being a boiler or plant so exempted;

or

(c) sells by retail any solid fuel other than an authorised fuel, for delivery by him or on his behalf to a building in a smoke control area, or to premises in such an area in which there is a boiler or plant to which paragraph (b) applies; shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st July 1976, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Chief Administrative Officer's Department, Town Hall, Halifax, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 27th June 1975.

Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area is bounded by a line commencing at a point at which the Calderdale Metropolitan Borough boundary crosses the Burnley-Todmorden Branch Line of the British Railways Board and thence following in a north-easterly direction the boundary of the Metropolitan Borough of Calderdale to the junction of the Pudsey Clough with Coal Clough Road. It then continues in a south-easterly direction and thence easterly direction tracing the edge of Reddishore Wood continuing in this direction following field Nos. 0594, 1788 and 2996 (Ordnance Survey Sheet S.D.9127), then in a southerly direction following Shaw Lane and thence in a north-easterly direction following the footpath from High Green End to Gall Lane. The boundary line continues in a southerly direction to the junction of Gall Lane with Blue Bell Lane, following Blue Bell Lane in an easterly direction to its junction with Whittonstall Clough, following Whittonstall Clough in a southerly direction to its junction with the Burnley-Todmorden Branch Line of the British Railways Board in an easterly direction to a point opposite Station Road in a southerly direction down Station Road crossing the A.646 Leeds-Burnley-East of Preston Trunk Road. The line then follows in a southerly direction the boundary walls of field Nos. 2600 to the south-easterly junction of field Nos. 0181, thence in an easterly direction following the boundary wall of field Nos. 0181, 9278, 8781, 7600, 6200, 5484 to the southerly tip of field No. 2882 (Ordnance Survey Sheets S.D.9024 and S.D. 9124) thence in a north-westerly direction along the boundary wall of field Nos. 2882 to its junction with Cockhill Wood, in a north-westerly direction following Cockhill Wood to its junction with Beater Clough, following Beater Clough the line progresses in a north-easterly direction following the Metropolitan Borough of Calderdale boundary to the point of origin at the junction of the said boundary with the Burnley-Todmorden Branch Line of the British Railways Board.

The area is approximately 375 acres.
