CLEAN AIR ACTS 1956 AND 1968

The City of Leeds (Metropolitan District) No. 3 (Morley West) Smoke Control Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Leeds City Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Clean Air Acts, 1956 (section 11) and 1968 on the 5th March 1975, made the above-mentioned Order declaring the area des-cribed in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order has been submitted to the Department of the Department of the Environment for confirmation. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the principal Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from the chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20.00 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than the authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity. In addition, in accordance with the Clean Air Act 1968, section 9 (1), any person who acquires or sells any solid fuel, other than an authorised fuel for use in a building in the smoke control area shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.00. If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st June 1976, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and plan referred to therein may be inspected free of charge, at the Information Centre, Civic Hall, Leeds 1, or Area Office, Town Hall, Morley, at all Hall, Leeds 1, or Area Office, Town Hall, Morley, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 4th July 1975. Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order, may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, Queen Anne's Chambers, Tothill Street, London, SW1H 9JY, object to the confirmation of the Order.
