

NORTH TYNESIDE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The North Tyneside Borough Council (Residents Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the North Tyneside Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Tyne and Wear propose to make an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

2. This Order will authorise the use of parts of the roads named in the Schedules to this notice as free parking places reserved for use by residents of the said streets only, whose vehicles display permits issued by the Council, for passenger vehicles, dual purpose vehicles, goods vehicles, invalid carriages and motorcycles.

3. Parking will be limited to the period between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any day in respect of those streets in Schedule 1; the period between 10 a.m. and 12 midnight on any day in respect of those streets in Schedule 2; and the period between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any day between 1st March and 30th September in any year in respect of those streets in Schedule 3.

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967
As amended

The Warwickshire County Council (Rugby Road and Southam Road, Dunchurch) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975.

The Warwickshire County Council (The Square, Dunchurch) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit or restrict the waiting of vehicles

(except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden) in Rugby Road and Southam Road in the Parish of Dunchurch as mentioned in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, to enable Post Office vehicles to deliver and collect mail, and to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and in the lengths of road where waiting is to be limited to one hour in two, to enable the vehicle to wait for longer than the permitted period if a Disabled Persons Badge is displayed on the vehicle.

It is also proposed to make an Off-Street Parking Places Order limiting waiting in the Square to 2 hours in 4 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive. The Order will specify the conditions under which the parking places may be used.

Copies of the proposed Orders together with maps showing the lengths of roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the County Secretary's Department, Shire Hall, Warwick, and at the District Secretary's Department, Town Hall, Rugby, on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals, which must be in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made, must be sent so as to be received by the undersigned by the 18th July 1975.

SCHEDULE

1. *Waiting to be prohibited at all times*(1) *Rugby Road,*

from its junction with the A.45 trunk road for a distance of 70 metres in a north-easterly direction, and including the slip road between Rugby Road and the A.45.

(2) *Southam Road*

(i) North-western side, from its junction with the A.45 for a distance of 87 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(ii) south-eastern side, from its junction with the A.45 for a distance of 77 metres in a south-westerly direction.

2. *Waiting to be restricted to one hour and return prohibited for one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive**Southam Road*

(i) North-western side, from a point 87 metres south-west of its junction with the A.45 for a distance of 38 metres in a south-westerly direction.

(ii) South-eastern side, from a point 77 metres south-west of its junction with the A.45 for a distance of 45 metres in a south-westerly direction.

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967
(as Amended)

The Warwickshire County Council (Birch Abbey, Alcester) (Prohibition of Entry) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given, that on the 26th June 1975, the Warwickshire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to stop vehicles from entering from the south the length of Birch Abbey, Alcester, which lies between the northern access to Chantry Crescent and Evesham Street.

The Order will come into effect on Monday, 30th June 1975.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads affected may be inspected at the County Secretary's Department, Shire Hall, Warwick, on Mondays to Fridays, inclusive, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road
