# The City of Norwich (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Amendment Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that Norwich City Council pursuant to an arrangement entered into under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Norfolk County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) 28(1) and 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of this Order will be to vary the provisions of "the City of Norwich (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order 1975" (the Northern Loop Order) as follows:

- traffic proceeding in a westerly direction will be able to enter St. Benedicts Street at its junction with Charing Cross for access only;
- (2) traffic travelling in a westerly direction along St.
  Benedicts Street will leave St. Benedicts Street via
  Wellington Lane which will now become one-way only in a southerly direction from its junction with St. Benedicts Street to Pottergate;
- (3) all traffic except buses and cycles will be prohibited from travelling in a westerly direction along St. Benedicts Street between its junction with Wellington Lane and its junction with Grapes Hill.

Lane and its junction with Chapes Fin.

The other provisions of "the City of Norwich (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order, 1975" are not changed.

"The City of Norwich (Central Area Traffic Control) (Amendment) Order 1970" is amended to provide three extra short lengths of parking places in St. Benedict's Street near St. Lawrence Steps, St. Swithins Alley and St. Benedict's Church allowing waiting for 30 minutes between the barre of 8 a.m. 6 30 n.m. Monday to Saturday. the hours of 8 a.m.-6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

### The City of Norwich (St. Giles Street) (One-way Traffic)

Notice is hereby given that Norwich City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Norfolk County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of this Order will be to make St. Giles Street one-way in an easterly direction from its junction with Bethel Street for a distance of 223 metres i.e. from its junction with Bethel Street to Guildhall Hill.

Exceptions to the provision will allow vehicles to proceed in a westerly direction in St. Giles Street if they are being used in a emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance

This Order will amend the City of Norwich (St. Giles Street) (One-way Traffic) Order 1969 so that emergency vehicles will be able to proceed in a north-easterly direction in Bethel Street.

# The Borough of Gosport (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1975

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968 propose to amend the Borough of Gosport (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1972 referred to as the "principal Order" as follows:

- (i) By adding to paragraph 2 of the Principal Order a sub-paragraph "'vehicle' includes any motor caravan, caravan, caravanette or other trailer".
- (ii) By revoking sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 6 of the principal Order and substituting "(b) shall not use, or permit to be used, the vehicle or any tent, shelter, or structure brought into a parking place, for human habitation, camping or for any domestic purpose".
- (iii) Revoke paragraph 17 of the principal Order by sub-stituting "the owner or driver of any vehicle shall not permit the same to wait in a parking place for longer than 48 hours at any one time."
