

## Y SWYDDFA GYMREIG

## Town and Country Planning Act 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the length of highway specified in the Schedule to this Notice to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission deemed to have been granted under Part III of that Act.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of 17th July 1975, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein. 30th June, 1975.

The highway to be stopped up is at New Tredegar in the County of Mid Glamorgan and is that length of the superseded route A4049 known as Elliot Street which extends from a point 40 yards north-west of its junction with the new length of the A4049 in a general north-westerly direction for a distance of 75 yards.
