At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 25th day of June 1975

#### PRESENT.

#### The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865(c. 73), it is enacted, inter alia, that all pay, pensions, or other allowances in the nature thereof, payable in respect of services in Her Majesty's Naval or Marine Forces to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council;

And Whereas by Order in Council dated the 16th day of February 1973 rates denominated in Hong Kong dollars and

conditions of awards of service pensions, terminal grants and service gratuities were laid down for Naval ratings locally entered at Hong Kong;

And Whereas it is expedient that the said rates should be increased;

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by the said Act and of all other powers enabling

Her in that behalf is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Hong Kong Locally Entered Ratings' Service Pensions and Gratuities) Order 1975.
- 2. With effect from the dates stated therein, the rates of service pensions, terminal grants and service gratuities for Naval ratings locally entered at Hong Kong shall be as set out in the Schedule to this Order. N. E. Leigh
