FAREHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Fareham Borough Council (Kings Road—Hartlands Road Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975.

Notice is hereby given that Fareham Borough Council made an Order on 9th October 1975, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The Order which comes into operation on 16th October 1975, makes it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to:

- (a) wait at any time in the undermentioned sides and lengths of roads:

Kings Road. East side from junction with West Street southwards to junction with Queens Road.

Queens Road

- (a) North side from junction with Kings Road eastwards to rear boundary of No. 16 Kings Road.

- (b) South side from junction with Kings Road eastwards to junction with Western Road.

Western Road

- (a) North side from junction with Queens Road eastwards to its junction with Hartlands Road.

- (b) South side from its junction with Queens Road eastwards to junction with Hartlands Road.

Link Road between Portland Street and Hartlands Road. On both sides of road.

Portland Street. West side from junction with link road south to roundabout;

- (b) wait Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the undermentioned sides and lengths of roads:

Kings Road. West side from junction with West Street southwards to junction with Western Road.

Hartlands Road

- (a) West side from junction with Western Road south with hammerhead.

- (b) East side

- (i) from junction with Western Road to southern boundary of R.C. Church site;

- (ii) from northern boundary of No. 1 Hartlands Road south and around hammerhead;

- (c) wait for a longer period than 2 hours in the undermentioned side and length of road:

Hartlands Road. From southern boundary of the R.C. Church site south to northern boundary of No. 1 Hartlands Road.

Exemptions to the Order will permit waiting for certain purposes including:

- (a) picking up and setting down of passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading of goods;
- (c) building operations, road and similar works.

A copy of the Order and a Map showing the roads affected may be inspected at the office of the undersigned during usual office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the 9th October 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

GATESHEAD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gateshead (Kirkstone Road, Pelaw) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1975

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th October 1975, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Tyne and Wear, the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

This Order, which makes it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on both sides of Kirkstone Road, Pelaw, extending over a length of 58 metres from the junction with Shields Road, will come into operation on the 20th October 1975.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods and where necessary in connection with:
- (c) the maintenance of the road, and
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The prohibition will not apply to invalid carriages and disabled person's vehicles displaying in the relevant position disabled person's badges issued by any local authority under the provision of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of the restricted road may be examined at the office of the undersigned on Monday to Thursday between 8.45 a.m. and 5 p.m. and on Friday between 8.45 a.m. and 4.35 p.m.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 16th October 1975, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Prices Lane, Upton upon Severn) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order, 1975.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.
