#### THE CAPITAL GAINS TAX

(EXEMPT GILT-EDGED SECURITIES) (No. 3)  
ORDER 1975

In accordance with section 41 (2) of the Finance Act 1969 the Treasury give notice that an Order entitled the Capital Gains Tax (Exempt Gilt-Edged Securities) (No. 3) Order 1975 has been made under provisions of that Act and section.

This Order adds the following gilt-edged securities to the category of stocks and bonds which are exempt from tax on capital gains if held for more than 12 months:

- 13½ per cent. Treasury Loan 1997.
- 12¾ per cent. Treasury Loan 1992.

The Order is published as Statutory Instrument 1975 No. 1757.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY EXECUTIVE

THE HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK ETC.  
ACT 1974

*The Employers' Health and Safety Policy Statements  
(Exception) Regulations 1975*

The Secretary of State for Employment hereby gives notice that on 27th September 1975 he made the Employers'

Health and Safety Policy Statements (Exception) Regulations 1975 which came into operation on 1st November 1975 under the powers conferred on him by section 2 (3) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and of all powers enabling him in that behalf.

Section 2 (3) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 requires every employer, except in such cases as may be prescribed, to prepare and as often as may be appropriate revise a written statement of his general policy with respect to the health and safety at work of his employees and the organisation and arrangements for the time being in force for carrying out that policy, and to bring the statement and any revision of it to the notice of all his employees. These Regulations except from the requirements of section 2 (3) an employer with less than five employees.
