#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State proposes to make an Order under Section 212 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 for extinguishing any rights which persons may have to use vehicles on those lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting

the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- a in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if that vehicle cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road; or
- b in accordance with a special authorisation for that use given by or on behalf of the County Council of Gwent or the Borough Council of Newport or the Chief Officer of Police for the Gwent Constabulary.
- c where the vehicle is an invalid carriage (electrically, mechnically or hand propelled), a vehicle that has been issued to a disabled person by the Welsh Office in lieu of an invalid carriage or a vehicle which bears at the Front and rear in conspicuous positions bades issued in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, as amended, or a badge having effect under those amended Regulations as if it were a disabled person's badge.
