

Service Road and Trunk Road Slip Road which lies adjacent to, and north of, the trunk road and extends from a point 868 yards south-west of Colney Lane to its junction with Colney Lane, and to impose one-way working in a westerly direction in that length of Trunk Road Slip Road which lies adjacent to, and south of, the trunk road and extends from its junction with Keswick Road to its junction with the trunk road, a distance of 102 yards.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the 23rd January 1976, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The North-West of Doncaster—Kendal Trunk Road (Thorlby Diversion) Order 197

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959 providing that a road which he proposes to construct near Thorlby in the County of North Yorkshire shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
2. an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him to stop up the superseded length of Trunk Road near Thorlby aforesaid.

A short explanatory notice on these regulations is appended to this notice.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The draft regulations complete the entitlement conditions for Invalid Care Allowance, the legislative framework having been laid down in the Social Security Act 1975. This is a new benefit for people who care for severely disabled relatives and it is planned to be introduced during 1976-77.

A severely disabled person is defined by the 1975 Act as a person for whom an attendance allowance is payable. The draft regulations extend this definition and also prescribe the amount of care required to qualify for Invalid Care Allowance.

The draft regulations list a wide range of relatives the care of whom may confer entitlement to the allowance and they prescribe the circumstances in which increases may be paid for child or adult dependants. The conditions relating to residence and presence in Great Britain are set out together with other provisions of a technical nature.
