WATER ACTS

YORKSHIRE WATER AUTHORITY

Compensation Water

Notice is hereby given that Yorkshire Water Authority (here called "the Authority") is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order (to remain in force for 6 months) under section 1 of the Water Act, 1958, authorising:

1. Temporary suspension or modification of its statutory obligations to discharge compensation water from its under-mentioned reservoirs:

(a) to reduce the quantity of compensation water which the Authority is required by sections 14 and 15 of

the Harrogate Water Act, 1901, to discharge from Roundhill Reservoir into Pott Beck from one million gallons (4,546 cubic metres) per day of 24 hours to:

(i) 667,000 gallons (3,031 cubic metres) per day of 24 hours whenever the total amount of water in that reservoir is less than 347 million gallons (1,576,000 cubic metres) but not less than 173 million gallons (787,000 cubic metres);

(ii) 333,000 gallons (1,515 cubic metres) per day of 24 hours whenever such amount is less than 173 million gallons (787,000 cubic metres);

(b) to reduce the quantity of compensation water which the Authority is required by section 15 of the Leeds Corporation Act, 1907, to discharge from Leighton Reservoir from 3,005,046 gallons (13,661 cubic metres) per day, inclusive of the discharge from Roundhill Reservoir, to:

(i) 2,003,363 gallons (9,115 cubic metres) per day, inclusive of any discharge from Roundhill Reservoir, whenever the level of water in Leighton Reservoir is less than 700 million gallons (3,182,000 cubic metres) but not less than 350 million gallons (1,591,000 cubic metres);

(ii) 1,001,880 gallons (4,554 cubic metres) per day whenever such level is less than 350 million gallons (1,591,000 cubic metres);

(c) to reduce the quantity of water which the Authority is required by section 10 of the Leeds Corporation (Consolidation) Act, 1905, to discharge from Lindley Wood Reservoir in to the River Washburn from 2,778 gallons (12.63 cubic metres) per minute to:

(i) 1,852 gallons (8.42 cubic metres) per minute whenever the level of water in Thruscross, Fewston, Swinsty and Lindley Wood Reservoirs is less than 2,738 million gallons (12,446,000 cubic metres) but not less than 1,369 million gallons (6,223,000 cubic metres);

(ii) 926 gallons (4.21 cubic metres) per minute whenever the level of water in the said reservoirs is less than 1,369 million gallons (6,223,000 cubic metres);

(d) to reduce the quantity of compensation water which the Authority is required by section 10 of the Harrogate Waterworks Act, 1897, to discharge from the Havarah Park Reservoirs (comprising Beaverdyke Reservoirs, Scargill Reservoir and Ten Acres Reservoir) into Oak Beck and its tributaries from quantities totalling not less than 200,000 gallons (909 cubic metres) per day to:

(i) a total of 133,000 gallons (606 cubic metres) per day discharged from any one or more of those reservoirs whenever the total amount of water in those reservoirs is less than 222 million gallons (1,009,000 cubic metres) but not less than 111 million gallons (505,000 cubic metres);

(ii) a total of 67,000 gallons (303 cubic metres) per day whenever such amount is less than 111 million gallons (505,000 cubic metres);

(e) to reduce the quantity of water which the Authority is required by section 10 of the Ripon Corporation Act, 1886, to discharge from Lumley Reservoir into Holborn Beck from not less than 100,000 gallons (455 cubic metres) per day:

(i) 67,000 gallons (303 cubic metres) per day whenever the total amount of water in that reservoir is less than 53 million gallons (242,000 cubic metres) but not less than 26,500,000 gallons (121,000 cubic metres);

(ii) 33,000 gallons (152 cubic metres) per day when the total amount of water in that reservoir is less than 26,500,000 gallons (121,000 cubic metres).

2. The abstraction of up to 40,000 cubic metres (8,798,504 gallons) of water per day from the River Wharfe at Arthington at NGR SE264453 out of such flow in the river as exceeds 180,000 cubic metres (39,594,962 gallons) per day as measured at the Authority's gauge at Addingham Low Mill.
