Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

London Borough of Islington Controlled Parking Zone No. 5 The Islington (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 23rd March 1976 made the above-mentioned Order under

sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to amend the Islington (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976, so that, except in the parking places designated by the Islington (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1976:

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited:

- (i) between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the streets and in certain parts of the streets listed in Schedule 1 to this notice;

- (ii) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays in the streets and certain parts of the streets listed in Schedule 2 to this notice;

- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited:

- (i) between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) (i) above;

- (ii) between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 11 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays in the streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) (ii) above;

- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the streets and certain parts of the streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Islington Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the streets and certain parts of the streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited;

- (e) any existing prohibitions on waiting by vehicles, on the sale of goods and on advertising activities in the streets and certain parts of the streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above imposed by the Islington (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 will be revoked where inconsistent with the above;

- (f) cycle parking areas will be designated in the streets listed in Schedule 3 to this notice.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraphs 2 (a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" will apply.

4. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st April 1976, of the map which indicates each road and length of road to which the Order relates and of the Islington (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1.
