- 11. An allowance may be paid to the dependants of any Officer, Rating or Other Rank, Royal Marines who is reported to be missing, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 9 to this Order.
- 12. All Officers, Ratings and Other Ranks of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines and members of the Naval and Marine Reserves while serving or training in Her Majesty's Ships or Establishments shall be liable to pay charges for food and accommodation. Payment shall be effected by deductions from pay at such rates and subject to such conditions as are laid down from time to time by the Defence Council or by the Admiralty Board on their behalf.
- 13. The relative Naval ranks of Chaplains of all denominations and of Officers of the Royal Marines for the purpose of the payment of allowances shall be as set out in Schedule 10 to this Order.

#### Revocation

1.

14. The Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pay and Allowances) Order 1975 is hereby revoked with effect from the date of this Order, without prejudice, however, to the validity of anything done thereunder.

## SCHEDULE 1

# University, Medical and Dental Cadets

- 1. Officers entered as University Cadets shall when at University or while undertaking acquaint or vacational training during their degree course have included in their pay an Education Grant of £2.02 a day.
- 2. Surgeon Sub-Lieutenants and Surgeon Sub-Lieutenants (D) shall have included in their pay an Education Grant of £3.00 a day.
- 3. The Education Grants referred to in this Schedule shall be recoverable in such circumstances as may be laid down in rules made by the Defence Council or by the Admiralty Board on their behalf.
