BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Bedfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No. 1) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th May 1976 the Bedfordshire County Council made the above-named Order under sections 72 (3) and 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is to impose a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on the following lengths of road in the County of Bedfordshire:

Potton Road, Biggleswade (Route B.1040) from a point 25 yards north-east of its junction with Nursery Close north-eastwards for a distance of 250 yards.

Soulbury Road, Linslade (Route B.4032) from a point 33 yards north-west of its junction with Knaves Hill north-westwards to a point 120 yards north-west of its junction with Bideford Green, a distance of approximately 705 yards.

High Street, Riseley (Route C.8) from its junction with Sharnbrook Road (UC 19) north-eastwards and northwards for a distance of 1,875 yards.
