WAGES COUNCIL**WAGES COUNCIL 1959****EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION ACT 1975*****Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain)***

The Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration as set out in the Wages Regulation (Rope, Twine and Net) Order 1975 (Order R (167)); amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration as set out in the Wages Regulation (Rope, Twine and Net) (Holidays) Order 1975 (Order R (168)); and (3) the revocation of Order R (167) and Order R (168). The Wages Council intends that the revised provisions shall come into operation on 26th July 1976.

Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notice R (169) copies of which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below. The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the proposals if made within 14 days from 22nd June 1976. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Rope, Twine and Net Wages Council (Great Britain), 12 St. James's Square, London, SW1Y 4LL. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals R (169).

DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971**

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of West Midlands) (No. 20) Order 1976" authorising the stopping up of Upper Cox Street and lengths of Cox Street West and Clevedon Road, Balsall Heath, Birmingham.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (District of Bradford) (No. 2) Order 1976" extinguishing any right which persons may have to use vehicles on lengths of Darley Street, Kirkgate, and Duke Street in Bradford.
