TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the lengths of highway described in the Schedule to this Notice, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of a new highway maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the Mid Glamorgan County Council.

During 28 days from the 24th June 1976 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Offices of the Merthyr Tydfil Borough Council, Town Hall, Merthyr Tydfil and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of State (quoting reference WR15/52/4) at the address stated below.

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are at Cefn Coed-y-Cymmer in the Borough of Merthyr Tydfil in the County of Mid Glamorgan. They are:

1. that length of Cross Street, which extends from its junction with High Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 7 yards, and
2. that length of Field Street, which extends from its junction with High Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 22 yards.
