**PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT**

**LINCOLN CITY COUNCIL  
CLEAN AIR ACT 1956**

*City of Lincoln (No. 13) Smoke Control Order 1976*

Notice is hereby given that the Lincoln City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 2nd July 1976 made an Order entitled the City of Lincoln (No. 13) Smoke Control Order 1976 declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto and delineated on the attached map to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st August 1977, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Secretary Solicitor's Office, City Hall, Beaumont Fee, Lincoln, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 10th August 1976.

Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State, Department of the Environment, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

**ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS**

**CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

1. *The County of Cambridgeshire (The Centre, Bar Hill) (One-Way Traffic) Order 197*
2. *The County of Cambridgeshire (Church Street, and High Street, Fen Ditton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 197 .*
3. *The County of Cambridgeshire (The Green, Willingham) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Cambridgeshire County Council propose to make Orders under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to

1. Prohibit the driving of vehicles on the road specified in column 1 of the First Schedule to this notice other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. Prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the sides and lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice.
3. Prohibit vehicles proceeding at any time along or across the area of the access road to The Green, Willingham, from its junction with Church Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 27 metres.

The Orders will contain exemptions to allow

1. Mechanical road cleansing vehicles to be used in both directions in the road between the hours of 6 a.m. and 8 a.m.
2. A vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable a person to board or alight; to enable it to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services and to allow a disabled persons vehicle to wait for up to two hours.

A copy of the proposed Orders, maps showing the roads to which they relate and statements of reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the office of the undersigned and at the office of the Secretary of the South Cambridgeshire District Council, Great Eastern House, Tenison Road, Cambridge, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 27th August 1976.
