EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Eastleigh (Central Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation No. 3) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on 2nd August 1976 the Eastleigh Borough Council made the above Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Revoke the Borough of Eastleigh (Central Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1973 insofar as it relates to certain lengths of Grantham Road, Derby Road, Cherbourg Road, High Street, Market Street and Factory Road.

- (i) at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the First Schedule hereto; (ii) for a period longer than one hour in any two hours between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iii) for a period of longer than 30 minutes in any one hour between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in those lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;(b) loading or unloading goods;

and where necessary in connection with:

- (c) the maintenance of the road;
- (d) the supply of gas, water and electricity;

(e) statutory duties and funerals.

Certain vehicles being used by disabled persons will be permitted to wait for a limited period in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraph 2(i) above and will be permitted to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in paragraphs 2(ii) and 2(iii) above. Residents' vehicles displaying a permit issued by the Borough Council will be exempt from the restrictions to be imposed

by 2(ii) above.

The Order will come into effect on 9th August 1976.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the road to which the Order relates may be inspected at my office at the Town Hall, Eastleigh during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make application to the High Court for this purpose.
