within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

The Mid Glamorgan County Council (Various Streets, Treforest) (Residents' Parking Places) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 28(1) and 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to authorise the use of those parts of roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice as parking places for vehicles in such positions as are specified in relation to those parts of roads in the said Schedule and of such classes of vehicles also so specified as display a valid permit issued by the County Council in respect of that vehicle.

Only those persons whose usual residence is at premises, the postal address of which is in any part of the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice, will be eligible for the issue of a permit. Details of the method of applying for permits will be made known when appropriate.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the parts of roads to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Taff-Ely Borough Council at the Municipal Buildings, Pontypridd, and at the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 2nd September 1976.

(b) Kingsland Terrace, eastern side, from its junction with Princess Street, southwards to its junction with Kings Street, a distance of approximately 212 metres (232 yards).		
(c) Kings Street, eastern side from its junction with Kingsland Terrace, southwards to its junction with Brook Street, a distance of approximately 218 metres (233 yards).		
(d) Queen Street, western side from its junction with New Park Crescent, southwards to its junction with Brook Street, a distance of approximately 396 metres (433 yards).		
(e) Old Park Terrace, western side, from its junction with Bridge Street, southwards to its junction with New Park Terrace, a distance of approximately 102 metres (111 yards).		
(f) New Park Terrace, western side, from its junction with Old Park Terrace, southwards to its junction with Brook Street, a distance of approximately 292 metres (325 yards).		
(g) Wood Road, south western side, from a point 10 metres (11 yards) southeast of its junction with New Park Crescent, south eastwards to its junction with Bridge Street, a distance of approximately 90 metres (98 yards).
